Program Participants using School Facilities:

Francis Walsh Intermediate School is in the process of having renovation, demolition and abatement activities performed throughout the building. The work started in 2018 and will continue throughout 2020. The upcoming abatement phase of the project involving asbestos and PCB containing materials are planned to occur 3 June through 30 August, 2019 in the main gymnasium. The building materials requiring abatement include asbestos containing pipe/pipe fitting insulation and PCB containing column caulking compounds and adjacent block walls.

The Connecticut Department of Public Health (CT DPH) is involved with this project since abatement will occur during school session. Abatement (**containment construction only – no removal**) is scheduled to be performed 1st shift between 7:00am – 3:30pm on 3 June until 13 June, 2019. The work from 14 June until 30 August, 2019 will be between the hours of 7:00am to 5:00pm and Saturdays and Sundays as needed and no student occupancy will be allowed for this time period. The first day of school is planned for 3 September 2019. Langan CT has performed the abatement/remediation design for this project and is working closely with CT DPH to ensure that the work will be performed properly. CT DPH will be reviewing and approving this portion of the project.

The intent of this letter is to inform you that asbestos removal will be performed June through August 2019 and will occur in regulated areas using appropriate engineering controls. The Connecticut licensed asbestos companies Standard Demolition Services, Inc. and American Vets Abatement Experts LLC will perform the abatement/remediation work. Langan CT, an independent environmental consultant (or its representative), will monitor the project. The monitoring includes, but is not limited to, daily inspections, air sampling during asbestos abatement activities and final post abatement visual inspections and re-occupancy air sampling and post remediation verification sampling.

As required by CT DPH, this notification is being sent to all parents and guardians of the children/students, faculty and staff associated with Francis Walsh Intermediate School.


